


Transfer Credits at Ryerson

- 20,000+ TC applications annually
 - Excluding block transfer
- Centralized application and processing
- Decentralized evaluation at department level
- Students apply for TCs with an offer of admission
- Processing and evaluation after offer is accepted
- Encourage students to apply ASAP soft deadlines
- No fee to apply in the first year April 1





Role of Nolij in TC Assessment

- Ryerson went live with Nolij Web in Fall 2014
- Nolij Web is a web-based document and imaging management system (DMS)
- It provides a standard workflow for evaluating applications
- Within Nolij the course outlines and supplementary course information are sorted into TC application folders





Detailed course outlines must be in PDF format; calendar course descriptions are unacceptable.

Uploaded course outlines are reviewed by the Transfer Credit Unit within 5 business days. Faculty evaluations for acceptable outlines can take up to 6 weeks; final decisions will appear on your Transfer Credit Report.

Outlines may be deemed insufficient by the Transfer Credit Unit or faculty evaluator. If deemed insufficient, the outline status on your Transfer Credit Report will revert to 'Submit course outline', and you will receive an email outlining the information required. You will be able return to this portal and upload the requested course outline details.

Program: Business Management

Before applying, review the transfer credit application website: ryerson.ca/transfercredits.

Self-service applications are available for all Ontario Colleges and Universities, and several out-of-province Canadian Universities. If your <u>previous institution</u> is set up for self-service application you cannot use this application.

Detailed course outlines must be in PDF format; calendar course descriptions are unacceptable.

Enter the following Information:

- Institution: Select the Institution from the drop down menu. If your institution is not available, email tcredits@ryerson.ca for assistance.
- Course Code Subject Area: Input a shortened version of the course subject using only letters. For example, for Communications, input COMM or COM.
- 3) Course Code Number: If your institution does not use course code numbers, enter 100 or 205 DW.
- Grade: Grading systems vary between institutions, so select the most applicable letter grade. The Transfer Credit Unit verifies all grades on the application.
- 5) Term Course Completed: Input term the course was completed.
- 6) Year: Input year the course was completed.
- Upload Course Outline: Apply for each course separately uploading the corresponding course outline.






Advantages of an Electronic Process









Training - Faculty Evaluators/Assistants

- Computer labs & multiple training time slots
- Robust testing and training environment
- Job-aids
- Q & A
- Personal 1 on 1 training
- Feedback make improvements
- A key decision notification



Getting Buy-in

- 70% of students surveyed in 2013 preferred online submission
- Secured high-level sponsors: Registrar & VP Students
- Secured faculty champions
- Roll-out through informal announcements when faculty visit the office
- Involve the evaluators focus group, testing
- Central log-in, Secure access (VPN)
- Official announcements



Implementation

- Worked together with all stakeholders from an early stage to ensure feasibility – limitations, cost, etc.
- Lessons learned
 - Allocate lots of time for testing test and re-test, a fix may have an unintentional impact
 - Middleware Java
 - Create access to a robust test environment
 - Project management essential JIRA
 - Provide responsive support to evaluators over the phone, email, in-person
 - 3 Cycles to iron out all the wrinkles
 - Celebrate success along the way!
